This **Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 3** is being issued in response to prospective bidder's (Wuhan Fiber Home International Technologies Phils., Inc.) e-mail addressed to the Chair dated 11 May 2018.

Queries	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It was mentioned in your response to question number 2 in bid supplement 1 "the local company does not necessarily have to bid in behalf of the foreign bidder". Does it mean, the local office can opt to participate on our own if we so choose, meaning either our Head Office or Local Office can participate, can choose or nominate which one of us will bid?2. If answer is yes to item no.1, can a local office of a wholly owned foreign company, who has a duly registered Philippine SEC registration, local Business/Mayor's permit, updated Audited Financial Statement and registered to Philgeps Platinum participate of their own, using existing, and current eligibility documentations mentioned be used to qualify for the bidding?3. If answer is no to item no. 1, and we need to secure eligibility documentation directly from HQ of a foreign entity, the BDS under C. Preparation of Bids " states that: "The eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents to be submitted to the BAC must be in English. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents submitted to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation of the documents in English. The documents shall be translated by the relevant foreign government agency, the foreign government agency authorized to translate documents, or a registered translator in the foreign bidder's country; and shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment/post or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid." If in our case the eligibility happens to not all to be in English (there are some in foreign language, some in English i.e Audited Financial Statement). Would the document (AFS) in English would still be required to be authenticated by Philippine foreign service establishment or equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines?
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PITC/DICT REPLY	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Yes, either the Head Office (which we presume is foreign-based) or the local office (registered under Philippine laws) can participate in the bidding.2. The local office that participates in the bidding must definitely use and submit its own eligibility documents as mentioned in your letter INCLUDING all other Class "A" eligibility documents stated in the Bid Data Sheet, to wit:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Statement of on-going government and private contracts (per Annex 1 of the bidding documents);• Statement of Single Largest Completed Contract of Similar Nature (Revised Annex 1-A of the bidding documents)• Duly accomplished and signed Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) (per Annex II of the bidding documents) or a Committed Line of Credit (per Annex II-A of the bidding documents)Take note that a local office CANNOT use or submit its Head Office's documents for purposes of the foregoing.3. Any document to be submitted for bidding purposes which is not in the English language must be translated into English and the English version must be authenticated by the Philippine foreign service establishment or equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidders' affairs in the Philippines. This rule applies to all bidders, local or foreign.
