<b>REPLY</b>	1. The thickness of the existing partition is 60mm to 65mm including the fabric board tile, melamine and main frame. As indicated in the Terms of Reference in the Bidding Documents, the new workstations must be inter-operable with the existing workstations including the configured units. 2. Yes, separate table for the main desk and side desk.
