WHEREAS, on 25 April 2019, PITC caused the posting of the Invitation to Bid of the public bidding for the procurement project entitled Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of One (1) Set Brand New Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Scanner 1.5 TESLA, (Superconducting Actively Shielded) with Accessories and Air-Conditioning System for the Department of Radiology – University of the Philippines Manila – Philippine General Hospital (UPM-PGH) under Bid Ref. No. GPG-B1-2019-105 in the PhiliGEPS, PITC Website, and in conspicuous places within the premises of its office continuously for seven (7) calendar days, as follows:

WHEREAS, in response to the aforecited postings, two prospective bidders bought Bidding Documents for the subject item, namely:

1) Cosmo Medical, Inc. (hereinafter "Cosmo"), and

2) Technomed International, Inc. (hereinafter "Technomed").

WHEREAS, during the scheduled submission and opening of bids on 13 June 2019, both Cosmo and Technomed submitted their Eligibility and Technical Documents and their Financial Bids for the subject item;

WHEREAS, on the date of submission and opening of bids, this Committee proceeded to open the Eligibility and Technical documents of Cosmo and declared Cosmo's eligibility and technical submittals as "Passed";

WHEREAS, having passed the eligibility and technical checking, this Committee proceeded to open the financial bids of **Technomed** and **Cosmo**, the result of which are as follows:

WHEREAS, being the bidder with the lowest bid, the Committee conducted Bid Evaluation on Cosmo and on 27 June 2019, issued to the latter the Notice of Lowest Calculated Bid for the subject item;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Post-Qualification procedures under the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 and after careful examination, validation and verification of the eligibility, technical and financial requirements on post-qualification, the bid submitted by Cosmo Medical, Inc. was all found to be post-disqualified as shown by the corresponding Notice of Post-Disqualification, a copy of which are hereto attached as Annex "B", and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, on 06 September 2019, the Committee was in receipt of a Motion for Reconsideration filed by Cosmo within the period prescribed therefor;

WHEREAS, on 13 September 2019, the Committee rendered Resolution No. BAC I/R-2019-09-214 which partially granted Cosmo's Motion for Reconsideration, where it required Cosmo to schedule a product presentation of the Monitor Diagnostic Workstation either at FEU Hospital or AFP Medical Center to UPM-PGH-PITC Technical Working Group, a copy of said Resolution is hereto attached as Annex "C" and made integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, after the product presentation/demonstration conducted at the FEU Hospital particularly the Monitor for the Diagnostic Workstation, the Technical Working Group's initial findings based on the brochures submitted by Cosmo on bid opening day, is still **not compliant**;

WHEREAS, the Committee rendered anew Resolution No. BAC I/R-2019-10-255 (f) which confirmed its initial findings that indeed, Cosmo's bid is not compliant, thus denied the Motion for Reconsideration of Cosmo, a copy of said Resolution is hereto attached as Annex "D" and made integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, no Protest was filed by Cosmo with the HOPE within the period prescribed therefor;

WHEREAS, being the bidder with the 2nd lowest bid, the Committee conducted Bid Evaluation on Technomed and on 08 February 2020, issued to the latter the Notice of 2nd Lowest Calculated Bid for the subject item;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Post-Qualification procedures under the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 and after careful examination, validation and verification of the eligibility, technical and financial requirements on post-qualification, the bid submitted by TECHNOMED INTERNATIONAL, INC. was found to be the LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID for the subject item, as shown by the corresponding Notice of Post Qualification, a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "E" and made an integral part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee I, hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To declare TECHNOMED INTERNATIONAL, INC. as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the subject item;
- INTERNATIONAL, INC. for the procurement project entitled Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of One (1) Set Brand New Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Scanner 1.5 TESLA, (Superconducting Actively Shielded) with Accessories and Air-Conditioning System for the Department of Radiology University of the Philippines Manila Philippine General Hospital (UPM-PGH) under Bid Ref. No. GPG-B1-2019-105; and
- c) To recommend the foregoing findings for approval of the PITC President.
