1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Department of Health (DOH)** intend to apply the sum of **PESOS: Three Million & 00/100 (₱3,000,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the **Procurement of Training for Medical Certification of Cause of Death (MCCOD) for the Department of Health-Knowledge Management and Information Technology Service (DOH-KMITS)**

Bids received in excess of the ABC for shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. PITC and DOH now invite bids from qualified entities for the Training for Medical Certification of Cause of Death (MCCOD) for the Department of Health-Knowledge Management and Information Technology Service (DOH-KMITS) (hereafter referred to as SERVICE).
3. A prospective Bidder must have completed a contract of similar nature within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids as follows:
- a) Single completed contract of similar nature within the last five (5) years equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC;
OR
 - b) Two (2) or more completed contracts of similar nature within the last five (5) years from date of submission and receipt of bids and the aggregate contract amounts should be equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC. The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least twelve point five percent (12.5%) of the ABC.

Similar contract shall mean "Projects related to Medical Certification of Cause of Death (MCCOD)"

4. **Training Completion Period** shall be within One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed

Training Sites shall be as indicated in the Terms of Reference per **Annex V-A**

5. Open competitive bidding procedures will be conducted using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by **R.A. 9184** and its **2016** Revised IRR.
6. The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders during office hours (8:00am-4:00pm) but not later than 4:00pm upon payment of a nonrefundable fee as indicated above. The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document. However, bidders who previously bought Bidding Documents under Bid Ref. No. GPG-B1-2019-004 may acquire Bidding Documents free of charge upon presentation of the Official Receipt.

It may be also downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Pre-Bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the documents for the bidder.
