1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA)** intend to apply the sum of **Pesos: One Hundred Sixty Million Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Seven Hundred Seventeen and 98/100 Only (₱ 160,216,717.98)** inclusive of VAT, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the Supply and Delivery of 69 Units Brand New Sugarcane Wheeled Grabber with Excavator for the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA) more particularly described as follows:

2. PITC and SRA now invite bids from Manufacturers or local First Tier Distributors for the Supply and Delivery of 69 units Brand New Sugarcane Wheeled Grabber with Excavator (hereafter referred to as GOODS).

“**First Tier Distributor**” shall mean a Philippine-based company directly appointed by the principal manufacturer.

3. **Project Completion Period:** Within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP)

Deployment Sites Refer to **Annex V-A2** as per Section VI. Bidding Forms of the Bidding Documents.

Note: Project Completion Period shall cover and include visual inspection and actual field testing prior to delivery at the deployment sites.

4. A prospective Bidder should have completed within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids equivalent to:
 - At least one (1) single contract of similar nature amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC; **OR**

- Two (2) or more contracts of similar nature equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC for the project the largest of these contracts must be equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC.

“**Similar**” contract shall refer to contracts pertaining to farm machinery with four wheels and engine, power rating of 20hp and above.

- Open competitive bidding procedures will be conducted using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by **R.A. 9184** and its **2016** Revised IRR.
- The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired/purchased by interested bidders during office hours (8:00am-4:00pm) but not later than 4:00pm upon payment of a nonrefundable fee as indicated above.

Pursuant to the GPPB Guidelines in the Sale of the Bidding Documents, the cost of the Bidding Documents shall correspond to the sum of the ABC of lot/s being bid.

The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may be also downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Pre-Bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the documents for the bidder.
