PITC and TESDA now invite authorized Philippine Suppliers or Resellers or Distributors for the Procurement of Starter Toolkits for the Implementation of Republic Act 10931 or Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act (UAQTEA) for FY 2019 for the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) (hereafter referred to as GOODS/SERVICES).
5. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
6. A prospective Bidder must have completed a Single contract of similar nature within last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC per lot.

Similar nature shall mean “**Basic Tools/Training Tools**”.

7. **Delivery Period:** Within ninety (90) calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP)
