



INVITATION TO BID

REPAIR AND RENOVATION OF ONE (1) LOT CONSISTING OF MAIN BUILDING AND QUARTER’S BUILDING OF THE BUREAU OF CUSTOMS (BOC) - PORT OF APARRI

Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC): ₱5,702,237.14

1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Bureau of Customs** intend to apply the sum of Pesos: **Five Million Seven Hundred Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Seven and 14/100 (₱5,702,237.14)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Repair and Renovation of One (1) Lot Consisting of Main Building, and Quarter’s Building of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) – Port of Aparri**, more particularly described as follows:

***The Cashier’s/Manager’s Check must be issued by a Local Universal or Local Commercial Bank**

2. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
3. The **Bureau of Customs (BOC)** through the **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** now invite interested Contractors with valid and current Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) License with Classification/Category in General Building/General Engineering with Minimum License Category of C or D and Minimum Size Range “Small B”, to bid for the **Repair and Renovation of One (1) Lot Consisting of Main Building and Quarter’s Building of the Bureau of Customs (BOC)- Port of Aparri** (hereinafter referred to as the “WORKS”). The PCAB license must indicate “PCAB registered contractor for Government Projects.”
4. Prospective Bidders should have completed a single contract similar to the project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC of the lot being bid for adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office consumer price index.

For purposes of this project, similar contracts shall refer to contracts involving construction of offices/buildings.

However, contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid may be allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB.

5. Project Completion Period: Within **One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days** from receipt of the Notice of Site Possession.

6. Open competitive bidding will be conducted using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (2016 Revised IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.” All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post Qualification procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.
7. Bidding is open to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
8. The Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents may be downloaded free of charge from the website of the **Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and PITC Website** at www.pitc.gov.ph. Interested bidders may inspect the Bidding Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on weekdays only.
9. The complete set of bidding documents maybe acquired by interested bidders upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above. The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of PhilGEPS and PITC, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Pre-bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the bid documents.
