RECONDITIONING AND REHABILITATION OF ONE (1) UNIT EMERGENCY POWER GENERATOR SET (GEN SET) FOR THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES HEALTH SERVICE COMMAND (AFPHSC)

1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Armed Forces of the Philippines Health Service Command (AFPHSC)** intend to apply the sum of **PESOS: Two Million Four Hundred Three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Six and 15/100 only (₱ 2,403,846.15) VAT Inclusive** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the **Reconditioning and Rehabilitation of One (1) Unit Emergency Power Generator Set (Gen Set) for the Armed Forces of the Philippines Health Service Command (AFPHSC)** more particularly described as follows:

2. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.
3. **PITC and AFPHSC** now invite Bids from local authorized Detroit Diesel service provider for the **Reconditioning and Rehabilitation of Emergency Power Generator Set (Gen Set) for the Armed Forces of the Philippines Health Service Command (AFPHSC)** (hereafter referred to as GOODS).
4. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
5. **Required delivery period and delivery place shall be as follows:**

6. A prospective Bidder should have completed a **single contract** similar to the contract to be bid amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC of the project **within the last five (5) years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids.

“Similar contract” shall mean Repair and Maintenance of Generator Set.



7. Open competitive bidding procedures will be conducted using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.
8. The Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and PITC website at www.pitc.gov.ph. Interested bidders may inspect the Bidding Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) on weekdays only.
9. The complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired/purchased by interested bidders during office hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) but no later than 4:00pm upon payment of a nonrefundable fee as indicated above. The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
10. For the Pre-Bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the documents for the bidder.
