1. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Philippine Navy (PN)** intend to apply the sum of **PESOS: Two Hundred Three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Five and 14/100 (₱ 203,883,495.14) (Inclusive of VAT)** being the **Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)** to payment under the contract for the **Marine Engineering Upgrade of BRP Artemio Ricarte PS 37 for the Philippine Navy (PN)-One (1) Lot**, more particularly described as follows:

2. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.
3. **PITC and PN** now invite Bids from MARINA Licensed Shipbuilders and Ship Repairers for the **Marine Engineering Upgrade of BRP Artemio Ricarte PS 37 for the Philippine Navy (PN)** (hereafter referred to as GOODS).
4. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
5. Project Completion Period (**including delivery of spare parts from the OEM**): **Within Three Hundred (300) calendar days from receipt of Notice of Availability of the Vessel.**
6. Project Site: **Contractor's Drydocking Facility that can accommodate BRP Artemio Ricarte PS 37.**

7. **The final acceptance and turn-over of the vessel shall be at the designated drydock facility of the contractor or nearest Naval Base facility within the Philippines**
8. A prospective Bidder should have completed **within the last five (5) years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids **at least one (1) single contract** similar to the contract to be bid amounting to at least **fifty percent (50%)** of the ABC of the item being bid for.

“Similar Contract” shall mean Dry-docking of Steel Hull Vessel.

9. Open competitive bidding procedures will be conducted using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. All particulars relative to this bidding including Eligibility Checking, Bid Security, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its **2016** Revised IRR.
10. The Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the website of the **Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS)** and **PITC website** at www.pitc.gov.ph. Interested bidders may inspect the Bidding Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) on weekdays only.
11. The complete set of Bidding Documents maybe acquired by interested bidders during office hours (8:00am – 4:00pm) but no later than 4:00pm upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above. The bidding documents shall be received personally by the prospective bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Pre-bid Conference, bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the Bidding Documents.
