- The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and the **Philippine Navy (PN)** intend to apply the sum of PESOS: **Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-One & 53/100 Only (₱12,500,961.53)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Consulting Services for Securing the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the Dredging and Reclamation and Various Infrastructure Projects at Naval Base Rafael Ramos (NBRR), Lapu-Lapu City, Mactan Cebu for the Philippine Navy (PN)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.

- PITC and PN now calls for the submission of Expression of Interest and Eligibility Documents for the Consulting Services for Securing the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the Dredging and Reclamation and Various Infrastructure Projects at Naval Base Rafael Ramos (NBRR), Lapu-Lapu City, Mactan Cebu for the Philippine Navy (PN). Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
- Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizen/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.



4. Prospective bidders must have completed within the last five (5) years a contract of similar nature equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

“Similar nature” shall mean **Consulting Services for Securing Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC)**.

The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his duly authorized representative upon presentation of proper identification document.

It may be also downloaded free of charge from the website of the PhilGEPS and the PITC website, PROVIDED that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

For the Preliminary Conference bidders are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the bid requirements and will prepare the documents for the bidder.

The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest and eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). Only the top three (3) firms will be invited to submit their technical and financial proposal. The criteria for shortlisting of Prospective Bidders - both the Company and the nominated Project Manager shall be evaluated on the following:
