In addition 1MOA = 1"/100yards the same with manufacturer standard. No need for modification.							

ELBIT SYSTEMS in its letter dated 14 October 2019 and received by BAC on the same date.

Query 3:	<p>Respectfully, the Joint Venture of Elbit Sytems Land and C4I, Ltd., and IMI Systems Ltd., would like to signify its earnest intent to participate in the forthcoming public tender for the "SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BRAND NEW 300,000 ROUNDS CTG 7.62MM BALL, SPECIAL, LR FOR THE PHILIPPINE ARMY (PA)" with "Bid Ref. No. MPG-BI-2019-369."</p> <p>Unfortunately however, despite our sheer intent to participate in the above tender, the onset of several important religious Jewish holidays in Israel commencing last 30 September 2019 (Rosh Hashana) and ending on 22 October 2019 (Simchat Torah), securing the necessary notarial seal and apostille for the pertinent bid submission documents from the relevant authorities, in compliance with the bid requirements due to these holidays proved to be difficult, if not totally impossible. The latter, considering both Elbit Systems Land and C4I, Ltd., and IMI Systems Ltd. is a foreign-based defense manufacturing entities, hence necessitating for all pertinent documentary requirements to be prepared/issued, notarized and apostilled in Israel, which from our experience will take more than ten (10) working days to complete, and only thereafter sent by courier service, which will also take at least three (3) working days for the original documents to be received here, hence the probability of being able to complete the necessary preparation of our bid submission on time, being very slim.</p> <p>It is therefore in view of the foregoing that the undersigned earnestly requests for your favorable consideration and approval to defer the submission of bids from October 24, 2019 to at least November 10, 2019.</p>
