This Notice is issued to advise all bidders and interested parties that the above-cited bidding project is being cancelled.

Bidders who previously purchased the Bidding Documents for this project shall be refunded the amount paid for the cancelled project.

Label and Washing Instruction Letterings for Coat and Trouser, which of the following should we follow? <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Yellow Paint as stated on page 97 of 165 para 2.4.4.1 for coat and page 98 of 165 para 2.4.4.2 for trouser b. Black Paint as stated on page 132 of 165 Test Parameters 2. Waistband to crotch on Trouser Table II with code CD, page 105 of 165 size XL (111.7cm) is inconsistent with the other sizes. Please clarify. Also, there should be bigger measurement grading for waistband to crotch starting on all sizes of large. 3. Carton packing on page 136 of 165 Visual Inspection Checklist 1.1.1.c, indicates the size measurement of carton which is 22"x16"x10" but on the specification page 102 of 165 para 5.3, there is no carton size specified. Please clarify. <p>We hope to receive the clarifications on our queries in preparation for production of samples.</p>

The said discrepancy shall be corrected by the concerned Office as soon as possible and wait for the corrected version shall be issued accordingly. 2. The said carton size should be indicated in the specification. Query 1:	<p>This is in reference to the Supply and Delivery of 230,903 sets Brand New Philippine Army Pattern (PHILARPAT) Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) Ver. A1 with Ball Cap for the Philippine Army (PA) under Bid Reference No. MPG-BI-2019-412</p> <p>In this regard, may we request the following concerns which we found out will be advantageous to both parties, viz:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Period for Rectification of Defects during Post Qualification – May we request to revise the grace period to correct the defects from 15 days to 30 days? Please understand that the modification of any defects will take more than 15 days especially on the fabric but for the make/construction of the uniform samples, 15 days is considerable. 2. Warranty period - May we request that the warranty period be changed from 1 year to 6 months only? Suppliers have no control on uniform’ usage/handling by the end user and fabric quality defers under certain environmental conditions. 3. Period for Rectification of Defects for delivered items – May we request to revise the allowable grace period to re deliver from 15 days to 30 days? Minimum quantities of each delivery 25,000 sets addressing defects on the rejected deliveries (just in case, God forbid!) would take a lot of time/days. 4. Single Largest Completed Contract – May we request that the SLCC within the last 5 years be changed to 8-10 years considering the ABC of the contract is too big (the biggest so far in Army Quartermaster tender) 5. Delivery Period – May we request that the delivery period be changed to the ff: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st Delivery – 25,000 sets after 90 days from NTP 2nd Delivery - 25,000 sets 30 days after the 1st delivery 3rd Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 2nd delivery 4th Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 3rd delivery 5th Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 4th delivery 6th Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 5th delivery 7th Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 6th delivery 8th Delivery – 25,000 sets 30 days after the 7th delivery 9th Delivery – 30,903 sets 30 days after the 8th delivery <p>Production of fabric for the entire quantity of this tender will not be singly produced. Each production of fabric has to undergo testing especially on its color quality and composition to ensure uniformity in all batches.</p>

Also may we request that PITC and PA Technical & Inspection Team will accept the delivery if the quantities is over the required quantities stated in the schedule of delivery. Said delivery will be treated as cumulative as per the schedule.</p> <p>7. As a local manufacturer, can we increase sub-contractors from 2 to 4 in order to generate more local employment considering the bulk of the order.</p> <p>8. As a local manufacturer, can we invoke the Domestic Preference?</p> <p>Thank you and hope to get the above clarification soonest. I remain,</p>

TEST METHOD <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - PA Specification does not specify the test method on QM SPEC NR IC – 21 PAPBDU – A1 dated October 22, 2019. - Kindly provide Test Method to be use.
