



**INVITATION TO BID FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BRAND NEW  
5,263 PAIRS SHOES, WET LOOK, LOW CUT, RUBBER SOLE AND  
4,964 PAIRS BOOTS, PHILMARPAT (PHILMARBOOTS, FIELD USE)  
FOR THE PHILIPPINE NAVY (PN)**

- The **Philippine International Trading Corporation** and **Philippine Navy**, through the **PITC A.R Nos. 0002944 dated 18 April 2018 & 0002565 dated 28 September 2017** intends to apply the sum of being ABC to payments under the contract for each item for the project **Supply and Delivery of Brand New 5,263 Pairs Shoes, Wet Look, Low Cut, Rubber Sole and 4,964 Pairs Boots, PHILMARPAT (PHILMARBOOTS, Field Use) for the Philippine Navy (PN)/ MPG-B1-2020-296**. Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot/item shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- Separate Bid Security per line item.
- Due to the inherent nature of R.A. 9290, prospective bidders shall only be limited to domestically accredited producers and manufacturers of footwear and leather goods with valid Certificate of Accreditation issued by the Board of Investments (BOI) pursuant to RA 9290, or “Footwear, Leather goods and Tannery Industries Development Act”.**
  - The **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** and **Philippine Navy (PN)** now invite bids from authorized distributors, dealers or suppliers for the above Procurement Project (hereafter referred to as GOODS).

5. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
6. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
7. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person, by facsimile, or through electronic means.
9. The **Philippine International Trading Corporation** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **25 November 2020, 2:00PM via Video Conference (Zoom)**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
10. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before **14 December 2020, 9:00AM**. Late bids shall not be accepted.
11. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
12. Bid opening shall be on **14 December 2020, 9:00AM via Video Conference (Zoom)**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend the activity.
