1. The Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC) and the Philippine Navy (PN), intend to apply the sum of Pesos: Six Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Six and 56/100 (P 6,250,466.56), being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Repair and Rehabilitation of Petroleum, Oil and Lubricants (POL) Dump at Naval Station Felix Apolinario (NSFA) for the Philippine Navy (PN) – One (1) Lot.

- 2. Financial Proposals received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected. Late Bids shall not be accepted. The Bids and Awards Committee have the option to negotiate on the Financial Proposal received that is within the ABC.
- 3. PITC and PN now invite Contractors with valid and current Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) License with Classification / Category in General Building / General Engineering, with Minimum Size Range of Small B and Minimum License Category of C or D with Specialty in Mechanical Works (SP-ME), to bid for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Repair and Rehabilitation of Petroleum, Oil and Lubricants (POL) Dump at Naval Station Felix Apolinario (NSFA) for the Philippine Navy (PN) One (1) Lot, (hereinafter referred to as the "WORKS"). The PCAB license must indicate "PCAB registered contractor for Government Projects."
- 4. The bidding is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
- 5. Prospective Bidders should have completed a single contract similar to the Project amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office consumer price index.
  - For purposes of this project, "similar contracts" shall refer to contracts involving construction or repair of Petroleum, Oils and Lubricants (POL) Depot or Gas Station.
- 6. Project Completion Period is within One Hundred Fifty (150) calendar days upon receipt of the Notice of Site Possession.
  - Project Site: Naval Station Felix Apolinario, Panacan, Davao City



- 7. Negotiation procedure will be conducted using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". All particulars relative to this negotiation including Eligibility Checking, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.
- 8. The Invitation for Negotiation and Negotiation Documents may be downloaded from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and PITC website at www.pitc.gov.ph.

Bidders who have participated in the last two (2) previous bidding can secure the Invitation for Negotiation and Negotiation Documents from the BAC II Secretariat c/o Ms. Irene G. Alayon at the 3/F NDC Building, 116 Tordesillas Street, Salcedo Village, 1227 Makati City upon presentation of original copy of Official Receipt.

Other interested qualified bidders can still participate and acquire the Negotiation Documents upon payment of a non-refundable fee as indicated above.

For the Pre-Nego Conference, suppliers are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the negotiation requirements and will prepare the documents for the supplier.
