## <u>HIGHLIGHTS OF PROCEEDINGS:</u>

- Chair welcomed everyone to the pre-bid conference for the Supply and Delivery of Brand New 9,000 Rounds Ctg. 40MM HEHV Linked for the General Headquarters, Armed Forces of the Philippine (GHQ, AFP). After which, Chair introduced the BAC members and the GHQ, AFP's Representative/s.
- Chair acknowledged the presence of the following prospective bidders present in this pre-bid conference; namely:
  - 1. Rheinmetall Denel Munition Pty. Ltd.
  - 2. Armscor Global Defense Inc.
- Chair informed that to be able to participate in this bid project, the prospective bidder should have a single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids amounting to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC of this project.

"Similar" contract shall mean "Ammunition".

- At the same time, this bid project is open to authorized/eligible manufacturers for the Supply and Delivery of Brand New 9,000 Rounds Ctg. 40MM HEHV Linked for the GHQ, AFP.
- Chair explained that the first part of the Bidding Documents is the Instructions to Bidders which should be read by the prospective Bidders at their own good time. What will be discussed in this pre-bid conference are the documents that are required to be submitted on Bid Opening Day;

- Chair started to discuss the Envelope System:
  - Envelope System: The system of submission is a two envelope system wherein Envelope 1 will contain the eligibility and technical documents and Envelope 2 will only contain the Financial Bid.
  - Number of Copies: All documentary submission must come in three sets. These will be placed in 3 folders marked: "original", "duplicate" and "triplicate".
  - Sealing/Markings: The two envelopes will then be placed in a master envelope. The master envelope will then be sealed and marked in accordance with the instructions stated in the Bidding Documents.

	Chair informed the bidders that PITC does not accept any provisional Tax Clearance, renewal certificate or claim stub because the GPPB has already issued a ruling that only the Tax Clearance itself is acceptable.
	Chair advised Bidders to only transact with legitimate employees of BIR.
Audited Financial Statements for 2016 and 2017	Submission will be the 2016-2017 Audited Financial Statements comprising of: Independent Auditor's Report, Balance Sheet and Income Statements, all page of which must have the stamp "Received" by the BIR.
Valid and Current PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership (Platinum Registration).	If a Bidder is already a PhilGEPS Platinum Member he can submit the Platinum Membership Certificate together with the Annex "A". The Platinum Membership will substitute for the four (4) eligibility documents enumerated earlier.
	However, if any of the documents listed in Annex A of the certificate has expired Bidders must submit the current one.
	Chair emphasized that any documents that have expired, the valid and current document together with the PhilGEPS Certificate must be submitted.

	Chair reminded the Bidders that the Committee does not accept any CLC issued by a Rural Bank or Savings Bank.
FOR FOREIGN MANUFACTURER	For foreign manufacturers the following are the eligibility documents for submission:  1. Valid and Current Certificate/ license/ authority to conduct business issued by the regulatory authority in the country where bidder is based.  2. Valid and Current Tax Clearance issued by Philippines' Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) Accounts Receivable Monitoring Division per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005.  3. Corporate Financial Statement or Annual Report for 2017 or 2016.  4. Duly filled up and signed form Annex I;  5. Duly filled up and signed form Annex I-A, with any of the following attachment:  • Certificate of Acceptance issued by the enduser; or  • Official Receipt or Payment  6. NFCC or CLC.

Annex IV Bid Security	Chair enumerated the types of Bid Security acceptable to PITC. These are:
	<ul><li>a. Bid Securing Declaration.</li><li>A form is provided for as Annex IV.</li></ul>
	Bidders should use the form provided by PITC because it is complete in contents.
	In order not to miss out on anything, Chair advised Bidders to photocopy the form or scan it, and then have the authorized representative sign the form and submit it notarized.
	The other forms of Bid Security are:  b. Cash or Manager's Check issued by the local commercial/universal bank equivalent to at least 2% of the ABC;
	c. A Bank Draft / Bank Guaranty or Letter of Credit issued by a local commercial/universal bank equivalent to 2% of the ABC. Issued by a local commercial or Universal Bank.
	d. Surety Bond issued by a bonding company authorized by the Insurance Commission.
	In case Bidders will opt for a Surety Bond, The Bidder has to submit a Certification from the Insurance Commission that the bonding company is authorized to issue Surety Bond. In addition to this, the Surety Bond should contain all the 14 grounds for the forfeiture of the Bid Security and it be written on Bond Itself.
	Chair advised the Bidders to show the 14 grounds to their bonding company so that the latter can include or type them on the copy of the bond itself.
	The fourteen (14) grounds is found in Clause 12.1(b) (i) (c) (3) (i) to (xiv) of the Bid Data Sheet.
Annex V-A Technical Bid Form (7 pages)	As the Technical Bid Form was flashed on the screen Chair's instructions are as follows:
	<ul> <li>There is an instruction on the top most part of the form that states "Please use the Bid Form. Do not retype or alter";</li> <li>Bidders to put the word "Comply" on all the line item on the column "Bidder's Statement of Compliance";</li> <li>All pages must be signed by the authorized representative of the Bidder.</li> </ul>
	Chair reminded the Bidder that if there are any blanks left out unfilled, the TBF will fail because it will mean that the Bidder cannot comply with the technical specifications.

	Chair advised Bidders to use the form that PITC provided in this Bidding Document.
	The form must be copied verbatim. But to be sure that nothing is missed out, Chair suggested that the form just be scanned or photocopied and then filled up.
	On the "I/We", the name of the authorized representative named in the Secretary's Certificate will appear on the line.
	All blanks must be filled up, appropriate boxes must be ticked off.
	On the Authority of the Designated Representative, the portion: Name, Title and Specimen Signature must be filled up.
	All statements from "a" to "h" must be complete.
	The last page must be signed by the authorized representative and notarized.

## ENVELOPE 2: FINANCIAL ENVELOPE

Envelope 2 will contain the Financial Bid of the Bidders where he will indicate the Total Bid price in words and figures which should not exceed the ABC.

Chair explained that similar to the TBF, the FBF cannot be retyped. It may be photocopied for purpose of the other 2 copies required.

Chair again reminded the Bidders that for any erasure, there must be a counter signature or initialed by the authorized representative/s.

- The Chair inquired for questions/clarifications. No reply from bidders.
- Chair suggest that Bidders can put everything in writing and not wait for the last minute to ask/raise
  questions. Which can be sent by email or fax. The details can be found in the Bid Data Sheet.

The Bid Opening is scheduled on February 6, 2019 (Wednesday 3:00 pm)
