

INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATION

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SIXTEEN (16) UNITS BRAND NEW FIBERGLASS REINFORCED PLASTIC WATERCRAFT (SPEEDBOAT) FOR THE PHILIPPINE NAVY (PN)

1. The Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC) and the Philippine Navy (PN) intend to apply the sum of PESOS: Three Hundred Forty Million Six Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Three and 36/100 (P 340,632,603.36) (Inclusive of VAT) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the Supply and Delivery of Sixteen (16) Units Brand New Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic Watercraft (Speedboat) for the Philippine Navy (PN) more particularly described as follows:

- 2. Financial Proposal received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of proposals.
- 3. PITC and PN now invite Proposals from MARINA Licensed Shipbuilders or Boatbuilders for the Supply and Delivery of Sixteen (16) Units of Brand New Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic Watercraft (Speedboat) for the Philippine Navy (PN) (hereafter referred to as GOODS).
- 4. The negotiation is open to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organization with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging citizens of the Philippines.
- 5. The winning supplier must present one (1) prototype sample within sixty (60) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Present Sample, which at the option of the Supplier may be part of the delivery.
- 6. **Required delivery period**: Within One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Produce.

7. A prospective Supplier should have completed within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of proposals a Single Largest Completed Contract that is similar to the contract being offered amounting to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC;

[&]quot;Similar Contract" shall mean Watercraft.

- 8. Negotiation will be conducted based on Sec 53.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation of (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". All particulars relative to this negotiation including Eligibility Checking, Evaluation and Post-Qualification Procedures and Award of Contract shall be governed by R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.
- 9. The Invitation to Negotiation and Negotiation Documents may be downloaded from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and PITC website at www.pitc.gov.ph. PROVIDED that suppliers shall pay the applicable fee for the Negotiation Documents not later than the submission of their proposals. Interested parties may inspect the Negotiation Documents upon presentation of proper identification during office hours (8:00am 4:00pm) on weekdays only.
 - However, suppliers who previously bought Bidding/Negotiation Documents under Bid Ref. Nos. MPG-B1-2018-390, MPG-B1-2019-157 Rebid & MPG-B1-2019-225 Nego may acquire the Negotiation Documents free of charge upon presentation of the Official Receipt for said previous projects.
- 10. For the Pre-Nego Conference, suppliers are encouraged to send their authorized technical representatives or personnel who are familiar with the negotiation requirements and will prepare the negotiation documents.
