This **Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 3** is being issued to extend the Submission and Opening of Bids and in response to comments/clarification from prospective bidders.

A) PRELIMINARY STATEMENTS OF THE COMMITTEE

The Committee issued Bid Bulletin No. 2 in response to the numerous queries from bidders relative to this Project. It was not the Committee’s intention to delay the responses to these queries. The Committee is fully aware of the magnitude, importance and complexity of this Project. However, not being the project end user but merely the procurement agent for DICT, the Committee had to refer the bidder’s concerns/queries to the DICT as these issues pertain to the Terms of Reference (TOR) and project requirements of DICT. While these issues were referred to DICT as soon as received from the bidders, the replies/comments and modifications, as applicable, to the project requirements were only recently provided to the Committee. Hence, the issuance and uploading in the PhilGEPS of Bid Bulletin No. 2 last 23 February 2018 with revisions to the DICT TOR uploaded in the PITC website on 26 February 2018.

Nonetheless, the Committee has noted deficiencies in the revised TOR and in the interest of allowing bidders to review and raise queries on the contents of Bid Bulletin No. 2 as well the TOR, the following new schedules are hereby announced:
